B At the outset, Shri Rabindra Samal, RPFC-I welcomed all the participants and elaborately explained about the various statutory provisions under the Employees' Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 and Schemes framed thereunder on coverage and on enrolment.

C. Shri.Rabindra Samal, RPFC-I elaborated the reason for calling for this Meeting about the coverage of all Building and other construction workers including contract workers under CPSU/Central Govt. Department. He drew the attention of the letter dated 09.06.2016 of this Office wherein the details have been communicated to them about the provisions for enrolment of construction workers indirectly employed by CPSU/Govt. Departments through outsourcing agencies and contractors. He asked the Govt. representatives to submit the list of Construction Establishments/agencies including the outsourcing agencies/contractors for examination.

D. (i) The contractor details were submitted by a) Airport Authority of India, Madurai

(ii) Southern Railways, Madurai promised to give the details and informed the details of different departments who undertake construction work and a letter may be addressed separately to the departments.

Thereafter, he expressed his desire to know the current status of compliance of each of outsourced agencies from CPSU/Centreal Govt. Departments as Principal employers.
